

SENATE BILL NO. 278—COMMITTEE ON COMMERCE AND LABOR

**SUMMARY**—Revises provisions relating to occupational safety and health. (BDR 53-1347)

**FISCAL NOTE:** Effect on Local Government: Increases or Newly Provides for Term of Imprisonment in County or City Jail or Detention Facility.

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EXPLANATION – Matter in ***bolded italics*** is new; matter between brackets [omitted material] is material to be omitted.

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AN ACT relating to occupational safety and health; prohibiting a person from holding himself out as an associate safety and health manager or a certified safety and health manager or using various titles, words or letters in connection with those professions without meeting certain requirements; providing penalties; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1       **Section 1.** NRS 618.710 is hereby amended to read as follows:  
2       618.710   1. A person shall not hold himself out as:

3           (a) An associate safety professional or use in connection with  
4 his name the words or letters “Associate Safety Professional” or  
5 “A.S.P.” or any other title, word, letter or other designation intended  
6 to imply or designate that he is an associate safety professional,  
7 unless he is recognized as such by the Board of Certified Safety  
8 Professionals.

9           (b) A certified industrial hygienist or use in connection with his  
10 name the words or letters “Certified Industrial Hygienist” or  
11 “C.I.H.” or any other title, word, letter or other designation intended  
12 to imply or designate that he is a certified industrial hygienist,



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1 unless he is certified as such by the American Board of Industrial  
2 Hygiene.

3 (c) A certified safety professional or use in connection with his  
4 name the words or letters "Certified Safety Professional" or  
5 "C.S.P." or any other title, word, letter or other designation intended  
6 to imply or designate that he is a certified safety professional, unless  
7 he is certified as such by the Board of Certified Safety  
8 Professionals.

9 (d) An industrial hygienist in training or use in connection with  
10 his name the words or letters "Industrial Hygienist in Training" or  
11 "I.H.I.T." or any other title, word, letter or other designation  
12 intended to imply or designate that he is an industrial hygienist in  
13 training, unless he is certified as such by the American Board of  
14 Industrial Hygiene.

15 (e) An occupational health and safety technologist or use in  
16 connection with his name the words "Occupational Health and  
17 Safety Technologist" or "O.H.S.T." or any other title, word, letter or  
18 other designation intended to imply or designate that he is an  
19 occupational health and safety technologist, unless he is certified as  
20 such by the Joint Committee of the American Board of Industrial  
21 Hygiene and the Board of Certified Safety Professionals.

22 (f) *An associate safety and health manager or use in  
23 connection with his name the words "Associate Safety and Health  
24 Manager" or "A.S.H.M." or any other title, word, letter or other  
25 designation intended to imply or designate that he is an associate  
26 safety and health manager, unless he is recognized as such by the  
27 Institute for Safety and Health Management.*

28 (g) *A certified safety and health manager or use in connection  
29 with his name the words "Certified Safety and Health Manager"  
30 or "C.S.H.M." or any other title, word, letter or other designation  
31 intended to imply or designate that he is a certified safety and  
32 health manager, unless he is certified as such by the Institute for  
33 Safety and Health Management.*

34 2. The Division shall report any alleged violation of subsection  
35 1 to the district attorney of the county in which the alleged violation  
36 occurred.

37 3. Any governmental entity that has issued a license to conduct  
38 business in this State as an associate safety professional, a certified  
39 industrial hygienist, a certified safety professional, an industrial  
40 hygienist in training , ~~for~~ an occupational health and safety  
41 technologist , *an associate safety and health manager or a certified*  
42 *safety and health manager* to a person who is convicted of  
43 violating any provision of subsection 1 shall revoke that license and  
44 send notice of the revocation to the licensee by certified mail.



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1       4. Any person who violates a provision of subsection 1 is  
2 guilty of a misdemeanor.

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
