

SENATE BILL NO. 286—SENATORS HORSFORD AND WIENER

MARCH 23, 2005

Referred to Committee on Human Resources and Education

SUMMARY—Requires Clark County School District to construct career and technical high school within certain area of Clark County. (BDR S-1228)

AN ACT relating to education; requiring the Clark County School District to construct a career and technical high school within a certain area of Clark County; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** 1. The Clark County School District shall
2 construct one high school designated as a career and technical high
3 school within the boundaries of the Southern Nevada Enterprise
4 Community. The school must:
5 (a) Offer a program of career and technical education to pupils
6 enrolled in grades 9 to 12, inclusive.
7 (b) Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2, be completed
8 and open for enrollment not later than August 1, 2008.
9 2. The Clark County School District may apply to the
10 Legislative Commission for an extension of the deadline set forth in
11 paragraph (b) of subsection 1 if the district is unable to meet that
12 deadline.



- 1 **Sec. 2.** The provisions of NRS 354.599 do not apply to any
- 2 additional expenses of a local government that are related to the
- 3 provisions of this act.
- 4 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2005.
