

SENATE BILL NO. 314—SENATORS TITUS AND BEERS

MARCH 24, 2005

Referred to Committee on Finance

SUMMARY—Makes appropriation to Atomic Testing Museum in Las Vegas for educational program. (BDR S-468)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the Atomic Testing Museum in Las Vegas for an educational program; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Atomic Testing Museum in Las Vegas the sum of \$220,000 for an educational program at the Museum.

2. The appropriation made by subsection 1 must be used to:

- (a) Provide instructional materials in classrooms;
- (b) Allow access to the Internet for teachers and pupils; and
- (c) Subsidize admission and transportation costs for schools and waive entirely admission for pupils who attend designated at-risk schools.

Sec. 2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2007, and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or before September 21, 2007.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
