

SENATE BILL NO. 314—SENATORS TITUS AND BEERS

AN ACT making an appropriation to the Atomic Testing Museum in Las Vegas for an educational program; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State
2 General Fund to the Atomic Testing Museum in Las Vegas the sum
3 of \$220,000 for an educational program at the Museum.

4 2. The appropriation made by subsection 1 must be used to:
5 (a) Provide instructional materials in classrooms;
6 (b) Allow access to the Internet for teachers and pupils; and
7 (c) Subsidize admission and transportation costs for schools and
8 waive entirely admission for pupils who attend designated at-risk
9 schools.

10 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by
11 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after
12 June 30, 2007, and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or
13 before September 21, 2007.

14 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
