AN ACT relating to state parks; creating the Account for Maintenance of State Park Facilities and Grounds; requiring the sale of a parcel of land within the Red Rock Canyon National Conservation Area to fund the Account; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 407 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3 ***1. The Account for Maintenance of State Park Facilities and***
4 ***Grounds is hereby created in the State General Fund. The interest***
5 ***and income earned on the money in the Account, after deducting***
6 ***any applicable charges, must be credited to the Account. The***
7 ***money in the Account does not lapse to the State General Fund at***
8 ***the end of any fiscal year.***

9 ***2. The Administrator may expend the interest and income***
10 ***earned on the money in the Account to repair and maintain state***
11 ***park facilities and grounds. The Administrator may expend the***
12 ***interest and income in the Account or allow it to accrue until a***
13 ***sufficient amount is available for repair and maintenance***



1 *projects. The Administrator shall not expend the principal of the*
2 *Account.*

3 **Sec. 2.** The Administrator of the Division of State Lands of the
4 State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources shall sell a
5 parcel of land within the Red Rock Canyon National Conservation
6 Area of approximately 80 acres to the Bureau of Land Management
7 of the United States Department of the Interior. Money received
8 from the sale, less any costs related to the sale, must be deposited in
9 the Account for Maintenance of State Park Facilities and Grounds in
10 the State General Fund.

11 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
