

SENATE BILL NO. 350—SENATORS TITUS, CARLTON, HORSFORD,
WIENER, COFFIN, CARE, LEE, MATHEWS AND SCHNEIDER

MARCH 25, 2005

Referred to Committee on Government Affairs

SUMMARY—Prohibits state agencies and local governments from outsourcing purchasing contracts to foreign countries. (BDR 27-65)

AN ACT relating to purchasing; prohibiting state agencies and local governments from outsourcing purchasing contracts to foreign countries; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 332 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, a governing body or its authorized representative shall not enter into a contract of any nature pursuant to the provisions of this chapter unless the contract and any subcontract thereto will be performed within the boundaries of the United States, its territories or possessions.

Sec. 2. Chapter 333 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the Chief, the Purchasing Division or a using agency shall not enter into a contract of any nature pursuant to the provisions of this chapter unless the contract and any subcontract thereto will be performed within the boundaries of the United States, its territories or possessions.



1 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2005.
