

SENATE BILL NO. 364—SENATOR NOLAN

SUMMARY—Creates advisory committee to association for interscholastic athletic activities and events. (BDR 34-746)

AN ACT relating to interscholastic activities and events; creating an advisory committee to the association for interscholastic athletic activities and events; prescribing the membership and duties of the advisory committee; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 386 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
2 thereto the provisions set forth as sections 2 and 3 of this act.

3 **Sec. 2. 1.** *There is hereby created an advisory committee to*
4 *the association consisting of eight members appointed by the*
5 *Governor in accordance with subsection 2. Each school district*
6 *that is a member of the association shall submit a list of persons*
7 *that the school district recommends for appointment to the*
8 *advisory committee, including, without limitation, coaches and*
9 *athletic directors. The persons recommended for appointment are*
10 *not required to be employees of the school district or otherwise*
11 *affiliated with the school district.*

12 **2.** *From the list of names received from each school district,*
13 *the Governor shall appoint members to the advisory committee as*
14 *follows:*

15 *(a) Four members who represent school districts located in*
16 *counties whose populations are less than 400,000.*



1 ***(b) Four members who represent school districts located in***
2 ***counties whose populations are 400,000 or more.***

3 ***↳ Each member must represent at least one athletic activity that is***
4 ***regulated by the association.***

5 ***3. The Governor shall appoint one of the members to serve as***
6 ***Chairman of the advisory committee.***

7 ***4. The members of the advisory committee serve without***
8 ***salary and without compensation for their service on the***
9 ***committee.***

10 ***5. After the initial terms, each member of the advisory***
11 ***committee serves a term of 2 years, commencing on July 1 of each***
12 ***odd-numbered year. Each member may serve not more than two***
13 ***consecutive full terms. If a vacancy occurs during a member's***
14 ***term, the Governor shall appoint a person in accordance with***
15 ***subsection 2 to replace the member for the remainder of the***
16 ***unexpired term.***

17 ***Sec. 3. The advisory committee created pursuant to section 2***
18 ***of this act shall:***

19 ***1. Meet at least twice annually and upon the call of the***
20 ***Chairman.***

21 ***2. Comply with the provisions of chapter 241 of NRS.***

22 ***3. Make recommendations to the association and to the***
23 ***Governor concerning the interscholastic athletic activities and***
24 ***events governed by the association and other activities for young***
25 ***persons in this State.***

26 ***Sec. 4. NRS 386.430 is hereby amended to read as follows:***

27 ***386.430 1. The association shall adopt rules and regulations***
28 ***in the manner provided for state agencies by chapter 233B of NRS,***
29 ***as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of NRS 386.420 to***
30 ***386.470, inclusive [] , and sections 2 and 3 of this act.*** The
31 regulations must include provisions governing the eligibility and
32 participation of homeschooled children in interscholastic activities
33 and events.

34 ***2. If the association intends to adopt, repeal or amend a policy,***
35 ***rule or regulation concerning or affecting homeschooled children,***
36 ***the association shall consult with the Northern Nevada Homeschool***
37 ***Advisory Council and the Southern Nevada Homeschool Advisory***
38 ***Council, or their successor organizations, to provide those Councils***
39 ***with a reasonable opportunity to submit data, opinions or***
40 ***arguments, orally or in writing, concerning the proposal or change.***
41 ***The association shall consider all written and oral submissions***
42 ***respecting the proposal or change before taking final action.***

43 ***3. In carrying out its duties pursuant to NRS 386.420 to***
44 ***386.470, inclusive, and sections 2 and 3 of this act, the association***
45 ***shall consult with the advisory committee to the association***



1 *created pursuant to section 2 of this act as the association*
2 *determines necessary and advisable.*

3 **Sec. 5.** Upon passage and approval of this act, each school
4 district shall submit a list of persons recommended for membership
5 on the advisory committee created pursuant to section 2 of this act.
6 The Governor shall appoint the following members to the advisory
7 committee:

8 1. Two members pursuant to paragraph (a) of subsection 2 of
9 section 2 of this act and two members pursuant to paragraph (b) of
10 subsection 2 of section 2 of this act to terms commencing on July 1,
11 2005, and expiring on July 1, 2006.

12 2. Two members pursuant to paragraph (a) of subsection 2 of
13 section 2 of this act and two members pursuant to paragraph (b) of
14 subsection 2 of section 2 of this act to terms commencing on July 1,
15 2005, and expiring on July 1, 2007.

16 **Sec. 6.** 1. This section and sections 1 and 5 of this act
17 become effective upon passage and approval.

18 2. Section 2 of this act becomes effective upon passage and
19 approval for the purpose of appointing members to the advisory
20 committee and on July 1, 2005, for all other purposes.

21 3. Sections 3 and 4 of this act become effective on July 1,
22 2005.
