

SENATE BILL NO. 370—COMMITTEE ON FINANCE

MARCH 28, 2005

Referred to Committee on Finance

SUMMARY—Makes appropriation to Nevada Cancer Institute for certain research, educational and outreach expenses. (BDR S-1390)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the Nevada Cancer Institute for certain research, educational and outreach expenses; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Nevada Cancer Institute the sum of:

For the Fiscal Year 2005-2006..... \$10,000,000

For the Fiscal Year 2006-2007..... \$10,000,000

2. The money appropriated by subsection 1 must be used:

(a) To fund researcher “start-up” packages and to purchase equipment needed for each recruit’s research; and

(b) For cancer research, education and outreach to define needs and implement preventative health strategies.

Sec. 2. Any balance of the sums appropriated by section 1 of this act remaining at the end of the respective fiscal years must not be committed for expenditure after June 30 of the respective fiscal years and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or before September 15, 2006, and September 21, 2007, respectively.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective on July 1, 2005.
