SUMMARY—Makes appropriation to University of Nevada School of Medicine for certain expenses of Pediatric Dental Residency Program. (BDR S-1070)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the University of Nevada School of Medicine for certain expenses of the Pediatric Dental Residency Program; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State
2 General Fund to the University of Nevada School of Medicine for
3 the Pediatric Dental Residency Program the sum of \$350,000 for
4 resident's stipends and the expenses relating to the lease of a facility
5 and the lease of equipment.
6 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by
7 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after
8 June 30, 2007, and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or
9 before September 21, 2007.
10 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2005.
