

SENATE BILL NO. 439—COMMITTEE ON FINANCE

SUMMARY—Makes appropriation to Fund for Aviation for rural airports to match federal money provided by Federal Aviation Administration. (BDR S-1098)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the Fund for Aviation for rural airports to match federal money provided by the Federal Aviation Administration; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State
2 General Fund to the Fund for Aviation, created by NRS 494.048 as
3 a Trust Fund in the State Treasury, the sum of \$150,000 for
4 enlargement, improvement or maintenance of rural airports, landing
5 areas or air navigation facilities in Nevada.
6 2. The money appropriated by subsection 1 must be used by
7 rural airports to match money that is available from the Federal
8 Aviation Administration.
9 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by
10 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after
11 June 30, 2007, and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or
12 before September 21, 2007.
13 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2005.
