AN ACT relating to traffic laws; expanding the authority of a governmental entity and an agent thereof to use photographic, video or digital equipment to gather evidence to be used for the issuance of a traffic citation; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 484.910 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 484.910 A governmental entity and any agent thereof ~~[shall]~~
3 ~~not~~ ***may*** use photographic, video or digital equipment ~~[for~~
4 ~~gathering]~~ ***in any configuration or manner the governmental entity***
5 ***or agent deems appropriate to gather*** evidence to be used for the

8 ~~permanently within a vehicle or facility of a law enforcement~~
