AN ACT relating to public employees' retirement; repealing the prospective expiration of the provisions governing allowances paid to certain retired employees who fill positions for which a critical labor shortage exists; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1      **Section 1.** Section 9 of Chapter 490, Statutes of Nevada 2001,  
2 at page 2406, is hereby amended to read as follows:

3            Sec. 9. **[.]** This act becomes effective on July 1,  
4            2001.

5            **[2.—Section 1 of this act expires by limitation on June 30,  
6            2005.]**

7      **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
