SUMMARY—Repeals prospective expiration of provisions governing allowances paid to certain retired employees who fill positions for which critical labor shortage exists. (BDR S-1107)

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 9 of Chapter 490, Statutes of Nevada 2001, at page 2406, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 9. ~~{1.}~~ This act becomes effective on July 1, 2001.

~~{2.—Section 1 of this act expires by limitation on June 30, 2005.}~~

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
