SUMMARY—Temporarily extends prospective expiration of provisions governing allowances paid by Public Employees' Retirement System to certain re-employed retired public employees and continues experience study. (BDR S-1107)

AN ACT relating to public employees' retirement; temporarily extending the prospective expiration of the provisions governing allowances paid to certain retired employees who fill positions for which a critical labor shortage exists; requiring the Public Employees' Retirement Board to continue an experience study on the Public Employees' Retirement System of the employment of certain retired persons by public employers; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Section 8 of Chapter 490, Statutes of Nevada 2001,
2 at page 2406, is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 Sec. 8. The Public Employees Retirement Board shall
4 conduct an experience study on the Public Employees'
5 Retirement System of the employment of retired public
6 employees by public employers that participate in the Public
7 Employees' Retirement System pursuant to section 1 of this
8 act for the period between July 1, **[2001,] 2005**, and July 1
9 **[2004,] 2008**. The Public Employees' Retirement Board shall
10 submit a report of the study to the Interim Retirement and

1 Benefits Committee of the Legislature on or before
2 December 31, ~~2004.~~ 2008.

3 **Sec. 2.** Section 9 of Chapter 490, Statutes of Nevada 2001, at
4 page 2406, is hereby amended to read as follows:

5 Sec. 9. 1. This act becomes effective on July 1, 2001.
6 2. Section 1 of this act expires by limitation on June 30,
7 ~~2005.~~ 2009.

8 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
