

SENATE BILL NO. 495—COMMITTEE ON FINANCE

APRIL 4, 2005

Referred to Committee on Finance

SUMMARY—Makes appropriation to Department of Cultural Affairs for expenses relating to creation of Nevada Online Encyclopedia. (BDR S-1410)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the Department of Cultural Affairs for the creation of the Nevada Online Encyclopedia; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State
2 General Fund to the Department of Cultural Affairs the sum of
3 \$350,000 for expenses relating to the creation of the Nevada Online
4 Encyclopedia.
5 2. The appropriation made by subsection 1 is contingent upon
6 the Department of Cultural Affairs obtaining matching money from
7 the Federal Government or other sources, or both. The Department
8 of Cultural Affairs shall submit proof satisfactory to the State
9 Controller that the matching money has been committed before the
10 money appropriated by subsection 1 may be distributed.
11 **Sec. 2.** The Department of Cultural Affairs shall prepare and
12 transmit a report to the Interim Finance Committee on or before
13 December 15, 2006, that describes the expenditures made from the
14 money appropriated by section 1 of this act from the date on which
15 the money was received by the Department of Cultural Affairs
16 through December 1, 2006.



- 1 **Sec. 3.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by
2 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after
3 June 30, 2007, and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or
4 before September 21, 2007.
5 **Sec. 4.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
