SUMMARY—Makes appropriation for restoration and preservation of exterior of Lear Theater in Reno. (BDR S-1382)

AN ACT making an appropriation for the restoration and preservation of the exterior of the Lear Theater in Reno; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State
2 General Fund to the Department of Cultural Affairs the sum of
3 \$394,443 for the restoration and preservation of the exterior of the
4 Lear Theater in Reno.

5 2. The money appropriated by subsection 1 must be used as
6 matching money for federal money provided by Save America's
7 Treasures and Heritage Preservation Services, National Park
8 Service.

9 3. The Department of Cultural Affairs shall prepare and
10 transmit a report to the Interim Finance Committee on or before
11 December 15, 2006, that describes each expenditure made from the
12 money appropriated by subsection 1 from the date on which the
13 money was received by the Department of Cultural Affairs through
14 December 1, 2006.

15 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by
16 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after
17 June 30, 2007, and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or
18 before September 21, 2007.



1 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
