**SUMMARY**—Makes contingent appropriation to Interim Finance Committee for allocation to Reno Sparks Convention and Visitors Authority to implement Truckee River Recreational Master Plan. (BDR S-1435)

AN ACT making a contingent appropriation to the Interim Finance Committee for allocation to the Reno Sparks Convention and Visitors Authority to implement the Truckee River Recreational Master Plan; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1      **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State  
2 General Fund to the Interim Finance Committee the sum of  
3 \$2,455,000 for allocation to the Reno Sparks Convention and  
4 Visitors Authority to implement the Truckee River Recreational  
5 Master Plan. This appropriation would be used to plan, obtain  
6 permits for, design and construct four projects along the Truckee  
7 River that would enhance the recreational enjoyment, aquatic habitat  
8 and water quality of the Truckee River. The money must be  
9 allocated as follows:

10	For Rock Park .....	\$650,000
11	For Pioneer Division Dam .....	\$650,000
12	For Ambrose Park .....	\$700,000
13	For Idlewild Park.....	\$455,000

1       2. The Interim Finance Committee will allocate the money  
2 appropriated in subsection 1 upon notification by the Reno Sparks  
3 Convention and Visitors Authority that Washoe County, the City of  
4 Reno and the City of Sparks have committed to expend an equal  
5 amount of money on the project.

6       3. Upon acceptance of the money appropriated by subsection 1,  
7 the Reno Sparks Convention and Visitors Authority shall prepare  
8 and transmit a report to the Interim Finance Committee on or before  
9 December 15, 2006, that describes each expenditure made from the  
10 money appropriated by subsection 1 from the date on which the  
11 money was received by the Reno Sparks Convention and Visitors  
12 Authority through December 1, 2006.

13     **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by  
14 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after  
15 June 30, 2007, and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or  
16 before September 21, 2007.

17     **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
