

SENATE BILL NO. 70—COMMITTEE ON LEGISLATIVE  
OPERATIONS AND ELECTIONS

(ON BEHALF OF THE LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC LANDS)

**SUMMARY**—Amends provisions relating to Legislative Committee on Public Lands. (BDR 17-427)

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AN ACT relating to public lands; clarifying the authority of the Legislative Committee on Public Lands to review and comment on certain matters relating to public lands; requiring the Committee to submit a report concerning certain actions taken by the Committee to the Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau; repealing prospectively the provisions creating the Committee; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

- 1      Existing law establishes the powers and duties of the Legislative Committee on  
2      Public Lands. (NRS 218.5367)  
3      This bill authorizes the Committee to review and comment on any matter  
4      relating to the preservation, conservation, use, management or disposal of public  
5      lands, which the Chairman of the Committee or a majority of the members of the  
6      Committee considers appropriate. This bill also requires the Committee to submit a  
7      report to the Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau on its actions during each  
8      biennium. This bill additionally repeals the provisions creating the Committee  
9      effective July 1, 2009.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1       **Section 1.** NRS 218.5367 is hereby amended to read as  
2 follows:

3           218.5367 1. The Committee may:

4           (a) Review and comment on any administrative policy, rule or  
5 regulation of the:

6           (1) Secretary of the Interior which pertains to policy  
7 concerning or management of public lands under the control of the  
8 Federal Government; and

9           (2) Secretary of Agriculture which pertains to policy  
10 concerning or management of national forests;

11         (b) Conduct investigations and hold hearings in connection with  
12 its review, including , but not limited to , investigating the effect on  
13 the State, its citizens, political subdivisions, businesses and  
14 industries of those policies, rules, regulations and related laws;

15         (c) Consult with and advise the State Land Use Planning  
16 Agency on matters concerning federal land use, policies and  
17 activities in this State;

18         (d) Direct the Legislative Counsel Bureau to assist in its  
19 research, investigations, review and comment;

20         (e) Recommend to the Legislature as a result of its review any  
21 appropriate state legislation or corrective federal legislation;

22         (f) Advise the Attorney General if it believes that any federal  
23 policy, rule or regulation which it has reviewed encroaches on the  
24 sovereignty respecting land or water or their use which has been  
25 reserved to the State pursuant to the Constitution of the United  
26 States;

27         (g) Enter into a contract for consulting services for land  
28 planning and any other related activities, including, but not limited  
29 to:

30           (1) Advising the Committee and the State Land Use Planning  
31 Agency concerning the revision of the plans pursuant to  
32 NRS 321.7355;

33           (2) Assisting local governments in the identification of lands  
34 administered by the Federal Government in this State which are  
35 needed for residential or economic development or any other  
36 purpose; and

37           (3) Assisting local governments in the acquisition of federal  
38 lands in this State; ~~and~~

39         (h) Apply for any available grants and accept any gifts, grants or  
40 donations to ~~aid~~ assist the committee in carrying out its duties ~~;~~ ;

1       (i) *Review and comment on any other matter relating to the  
2 preservation, conservation, use, management or disposal of public  
3 lands deemed appropriate by the Chairman of the Committee or by  
4 a majority of the members of the Committee.*

5       2. *On or before January 15 of each odd-numbered year, the  
6 Committee shall submit to the Director of the Legislative Counsel  
7 Bureau for transmittal to the Legislature a report concerning any  
8 action that the Committee had taken pursuant to subsection 1  
9 during that biennium.*

10      3. Any reference in this section to federal policies, rules,  
11 regulations and related federal laws includes those which are  
12 proposed as well as those which are enacted or adopted.

13      **Sec. 2.** NRS 218.536, 218.5361, 218.5363, 218.5365,  
14 218.5367, 218.5368, 218.5369 and 218.5371 are hereby repealed.

15      **Sec. 3.** 1. This section and section 1 of this act become  
16 effective upon passage and approval.

17      2. Section 2 of this act becomes effective on July 1, 2009.
