University of Nevada to grant waivers for
registration and laboratory fees for active members
of Nevada National Guard. (BDR S-89)

AN ACT relating to education; making permanent the authority of
the Board of Regents of the University of Nevada to grant
waivers for registration and laboratory fees for active
members of the Nevada National Guard; and providing
other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

- 1 Existing law authorizes the Board of Regents of the University of Nevada to
 - 2 grant waivers for registration and laboratory fees for active members of the Nevada
 - 3 National Guard. This provision expires by limitation on June 30, 2005.
 - 4 This bill removes the provision which makes the authority expire by limitation.
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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Section 2 of chapter 9, Statutes of Nevada 2003,
2 20th Special Session, at page 272, is hereby amended to read as
3 follows:

4 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective upon passage and
5 approval and applies retroactively from and after July 1, 2003
6 . ~~[, and expires by limitation on June 30, 2005.]~~

7 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval
8 or June 30, 2005, whichever is earlier.
