SUMMARY—Makes supplemental appropriation to Department of Human Resources for unanticipated shortfall in money for Fiscal Year 2004-2005 resulting from increased cost of maintenance of effort requirement for Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment Block Grant. (BDR S-1190)

AN ACT making a supplemental appropriation to the Health Division of the Department of Human Resources for an unanticipated shortfall in money for Fiscal Year 2004-2005 resulting from the increased cost of the maintenance of effort requirement for the Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment Block Grant; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State
2 General Fund to the Health Division of the Department of Human
3 Resources the sum of \$361,620 for an unanticipated shortfall in
4 money for Fiscal Year 2004-2005 resulting from the increased cost
5 of the maintenance of effort requirement for the Substance Abuse
6 Prevention and Treatment Block Grant. This appropriation is
7 supplemental to that made by section 19 of chapter 327, Statutes of
8 Nevada 2003, at page 1833.



1 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
