SUMMARY—Makes supplemental appropriation to Department of Public Safety for unanticipated out-of-state travel, in-state travel and operating expenses for dignitary protection. (BDR S-1193)

AN ACT making a supplemental appropriation to the Department of Public Safety for unanticipated out-of-state travel, in-state travel and operating expenses for dignitary protection; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
2 Fund to the Department of Public Safety the sum of \$38,000 for
3 unanticipated out-of-state travel, in-state travel and operating
4 expenses for Fiscal Year 2004-2005 for dignitary protection. This
5 appropriation is supplemental to that made by section 28 of chapter
6 327, Statutes of Nevada 2003, at page 1836.
7 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
