SUMMARY—Makes appropriation to Department of Administration to provide necessary assistance to Task Force on Prostate Cancer. (BDR S-1210)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the Department of Administration to provide necessary assistance to the Task Force on Prostate Cancer; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State
2 General Fund to the Department of Administration the sum of
3 \$50,000 for allocation to provide necessary assistance to the Task
4 Force on Prostate Cancer.
5 2. Upon acceptance of the money appropriated by subsection 1,
6 the Task Force on Prostate Cancer agrees to:
7 (a) Prepare and transmit a report to the Interim Finance
8 Committee on or before December 15, 2006, that describes each
9 expenditure made from the money appropriated by subsection 1
10 from the date on which the money was received by the Task Force
11 on Prostate Cancer through December 1, 2006; and
12 (b) Upon request of the Legislative Commission, make available
13 to the Legislative Auditor any books, accounts, claims, reports,
14 vouchers or other records of information, confidential or otherwise



1 and irrespective of their form or location, which the Legislative
2 Auditor deems necessary to conduct any audit of the use of the
3 money appropriated pursuant to subsection 1.

4 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by
5 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after
6 June 30, 2007, and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or
7 before September 21, 2007.

8 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
