SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION—Commending Dean Richard Morgan and the William S. Boyd School of Law for the success of the law school and contributions to the betterment of the State of Nevada.

1        WHEREAS, Dean Richard Morgan has served with distinction in  
2 the United States legal education community for more than 24 years,  
3 including service as Dean of the Arizona State University College of  
4 Law and Dean of the University of Wyoming College of Law,  
5 service on behalf of the American Bar Association and the  
6 Association of American Law Schools and a career that has been  
7 marked by awards for excellence and leadership; and

1        WHEREAS, Dean Richard Morgan was selected in 1997 to be the  
2 founding Dean of the William S. Boyd School of Law at the  
3 University of Nevada, Las Vegas, the first public law school in  
4 the State of Nevada; and

5        WHEREAS, Dean Richard Morgan, by virtue of his experience,  
6 talent, commitment and vision, planned the creation of the William  
7 S. Boyd School of Law, recruited an outstanding faculty of leading  
8 legal educators from throughout the country and led the school,  
9 following its opening in August of 1998, to provisional and full  
10 accreditation by the American Bar Association and membership in  
11 the Association of American Law Schools in record time; and

12      WHEREAS, Due in large measure to the leadership of Dean  
13 Richard Morgan, the William S. Boyd School of Law has become  
14 an outstanding center for legal education and scholarship as well as  
15 faculty and student involvement in programs designed to enhance  
16 the understanding and practice of law and service to the State of  
17 Nevada; and

18      WHEREAS, In 2003, in its first ranking as an accredited law  
19 school, the William S. Boyd School of Law was ranked 82nd out of  
20 187 accredited law schools in the United States by *U.S. News &*  
21 *World Report*, which is an unprecedented ranking for a new law  
22 school; and

23      WHEREAS, Recognition of the William S. Boyd School of Law  
24 as a leading center for legal education is demonstrated by the fact  
25 that in 2004 the school received more than 14 applicants for each  
26 available seat in its first-year class; and

27      WHEREAS, Graduates of the William S. Boyd School of Law  
28 already are demonstrating leadership in positions of responsibility,  
29 including those in the Nevada State Legislature; now, therefore, be  
30 it

31      RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, THE  
32 ASSEMBLY CONCURRING, That Dean Richard Morgan and the  
33 administrators, faculty, students and supporters of the William S.  
34 Boyd School of Law are to be commended for the school's success  
35 and contributions to the betterment of the State of Nevada; and be it
