SENATE RESOLUTION—Inducting Horace H. Coryell into the Senate Hall of Fame.

1 WHEREAS, The Senate of the Legislature of the State of Nevada  
2 has established a Senate Hall of Fame whose members are selected  
3 by leadership from those past Senators who have served with  
4 distinction and who have made exemplary contributions to the State  
5 of Nevada; and

6 WHEREAS, Horace H. Coryell represented Elko County in the  
7 Nevada Legislature for a total of 20 years, by serving intermittently  
8 in the Nevada Assembly for 12 years and in the Nevada Senate for 8  
9 years during the period from 1888 through 1918, which service  
10 included ten regular sessions and two special sessions of the Nevada  
11 Legislature; and

12 WHEREAS, As a result of his intermittent service, Horace H.  
13 Coryell enjoys the distinction of having served the most legislative  
14 sessions as a freshman Legislator, five as an Assemblyman and one  
15 as a Senator; and

16 WHEREAS, During his service in the Legislature, Horace H.  
17 Coryell held leadership roles in both Houses, serving as Assembly  
18 Speaker Pro Tempore during the 19th and 20th Regular Sessions of  
19 the Nevada Legislature (1899 and 1901) and as Senate President Pro  
20 Tempore during the 26th Regular Session of the Nevada Legislature  
21 (1913); and

1        WHEREAS, An ardent advocate for his constituency, Horace H.  
2 Coryell was proudest of the legislation that he sponsored in the  
3 Senate during the 26th Regular Session of the Nevada Legislature  
4 which authorized the issuance of bonds to fund the construction,  
5 equipment and furnishing of a high school building in his  
6 community of residence, the town of Wells; now, therefore, be it

7        RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, That  
8 Horace H. Coryell, who served as an influential leader in the  
9 Nevada Legislature during the 19th and 20th centuries and who  
10 devoted many years of his life to serving the public, is hereby  
11 inducted into the Senate Hall of Fame of the Legislature of the State  
12 of Nevada.
