SUMMARY—Provides certain benefits to members of the Nevada National Guard and their families relating to licenses, tags or permits for fishing, hunting or trapping. (BDR 45-833)

AN ACT relating to wildlife; revising provisions that provide certain benefits for licenses, tags or permits for hunting, fishing or trapping to certain members of the Armed Forces of the United States and their families to provide those benefits to certain members of the Nevada National Guard and their families; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 Existing law provides certain benefits relating to obtaining licenses, tags or
2 permits for hunting, fishing or trapping to certain members of the Armed Forces of
3 the United States and their families. (NRS 502.070, 502.290) This bill extends
4 those benefits to certain members of the Nevada National Guard and their families.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 502.070 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 502.070 1. The Department shall issue to any member of the
3 Armed Forces of the United States who has been assigned to

1 permanent duty, as opposed to temporary or casual duty, within the
2 State of Nevada ***or to any member of the Nevada National Guard***
3 all necessary hunting or fishing licenses, tags or permits for fishing,
4 hunting or trapping in the State of Nevada. A like privilege must be
5 extended to spouses and dependents, under the age of 21, of such
6 members of the Armed Forces ***[.] or the Nevada National Guard.***
7 All such licenses, tags or permits must be issued on the same terms
8 and conditions and at the same costs as licenses, tags or permits are
9 issued to Nevada residents, except that the 6 months' residence
10 requirement must be waived.

11 2. The issuance of all such licenses, tags and permits must be
12 made by application upon a form provided for that purpose by the
13 Department. The application must include such proof of assignment
14 to permanent duty within the State of Nevada ***or membership in the***
15 ***Nevada National Guard*** as may be deemed necessary by the
16 Department to determine whether or not an applicant is ***[factually so***
17 ***assigned.] eligible for a license, tag or permit pursuant to***
18 ***subsection 1.***

19 **Sec. 2.** NRS 502.290 is hereby amended to read as follows:
20 502.290 1. The ***[Commission is authorized to issue to those***
21 ***persons serving in the Armed Forces of the United States who are***
22 ***bona fide residents of the State of Nevada] Department may issue***
23 fishing or hunting licenses, upon the payment of \$5 for each license,
24 ***[provided those persons requesting the licenses are at the time on] to***
25 ***any person who is a bona fide resident of the State of Nevada and***
26 ***is:***

27 (a) ***On*** active duty in the Armed Forces of the United States
28 ***[and are not stationed in the State of Nevada.] ; or***
29 (b) ***A member of the Nevada National Guard on active service***
30 ***in full-time National Guard duty, as defined in 10 U.S.C. §***
31 ***101(d)(5).***

32 2. The ***[Commission] Department*** may require whatever proof
33 it deems necessary to determine whether ***[such persons come within]***
34 ***a person is subject to*** the provisions of this section.

35 3. Any person who is guilty of giving false information to
36 obtain a license as provided in this section is guilty of a
37 misdemeanor.
