CHAPTER.....

AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; requiring the Department of
Transportation to erect advisory signs designating the lanes in
which certain larger vehicles should travel; and providing
other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel’s Digest:

This bill requires the Department of Transportation to erect advisory signs on
controlled-access facilities within their jurisdiction which have three or more lanes
for traffic traveling in one direction regarding the lanes in which vehicles with a
declared gross weight in excess of 26,000 pounds should travel.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 484 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
thereto a new section to read as follows:

*1. The Department of Transportation may erect advisory
signs at reasonable intervals on any controlled-access facility
within its jurisdiction which has three or more lanes for traffic
traveling in one direction to advise operators of vehicles with a
declared gross weight in excess of 26,000 pounds in which lanes
they should travel.*

*2. As used in this section, “controlled-access facility” means
a highway or street especially designed for through traffic, and
over, from or to which owners or occupants of abutting land or
other persons have no right or easement, or only a controlled right
or easement of access, light, air or view, by reason of the fact that
their property abuts upon the controlled-access facility or for any
other reason.*
