AN ACT relating to ethics in government; requiring certain public officers to attend a course on laws relating to ethics in government; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

1      Section 1 of this bill requires newly elected or appointed public officers who  
2      are required to file statements of financial disclosure to take a course on laws  
3      relating to governmental ethics that is conducted by the Commission on Ethics.

4      Section 1 of this bill also authorizes the Commission to develop a course on  
5      governmental ethics for the public.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1      **Section 1.** Chapter 281 of NRS is hereby amended by adding  
2      thereto a new section to read as follows:

3      ***1. The Commission shall develop a course on laws relating to  
4      ethics in government. Each public officer who is required to file a  
5      statement of financial disclosure pursuant to NRS 281.541,  
6      281.559 or 281.561 shall complete such a course within 6 months  
7      after his initial election or appointment to his office.***

- 1      **2. The Commission may:**  
2      **(a) Develop and offer to members of the public a course on**  
3      **ethics in government; and**  
4      **(b) Establish and collect a fee for a member of the public to**  
5      **attend the course described in paragraph (a).**

8      **this act** may be cited as the Nevada Ethics in Government Law.

11     **section 1 of this act**, unless the context otherwise requires, the
