SUMMARY—Establishes a formula for determining the maximum rate for interruptible service that a public utility may charge for electricity for irrigation pumps. (BDR 58-1017)

AN ACT relating to electricity; establishing a formula for determining the maximum rate for interruptible service that a public utility may charge for electricity for irrigation pumps; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 Under existing law, a public utility which furnishes electricity for irrigation
2 pumps may not charge a rate for interruptible service that exceeds the lowest charge
3 per kilowatt-hour offered by the public utility under any of its rate schedules for its
4 customers in this State. (NRS 704.225) This bill establishes a formula for
5 determining the maximum rate for interruptible service that a public utility may
6 charge for the service.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 704.225 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 704.225 **1.** The Commission shall by regulation require each
3 public utility which furnishes electricity to provide lower rates for
4 electricity for irrigation pumps under a schedule which:
5 ~~[(1)]~~ **(a)** Will be applied:
6 ~~[(a)]~~ **(1)** From March 1 to October 31, inclusive; and
7 ~~[(b)]~~ **(2)** If the customer concedes to the utility a right to
8 interrupt services to the customer's irrigation pumps under
9 conditions established by the utility and approved by the
10 Commission.
11 ~~[(2)]~~ **(b)** Provides for a *maximum* rate for interruptible service
12 per kilowatt-hour of electricity used. The rate must ~~[not exceed]~~ *be*
13 *determined by dividing the sum of* the lowest charge per kilowatt-
14 hour offered by ~~[the]~~ *each* public utility *and each cooperative*
15 *association* under any of its rate schedules applicable to its
16 residential, commercial or industrial customers *or members* in
17 Nevada ~~[(1)]~~ *by the total number of public utilities and cooperative*
18 *associations which furnish electricity in this State.* No charges may
19 be included for minimum billings or costs relating to standby,
20 customers or demand. *A public utility or cooperative association*
21 *shall provide such information as is necessary for the Commission*
22 *to determine the maximum rate for interruptible service pursuant*
23 *to this section.*
24 **2.** *As used in this section:*
25 **(a)** *“Cooperative association” means a cooperative*
26 *association, nonprofit cooperation or association or any other*
27 *provider of services described in this chapter that supplies those*
28 *services for the use of its members; and*
29 **(b)** *“Public utility” includes a municipal utility as defined in*
30 *NRS 702.060.*
