AN ACT relating to medical laboratories; exempting tests and examinations requested by a court pursuant to a program of treatment and rehabilitation from certain restrictions relating to tests and examinations conducted in medical laboratories; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 Existing law establishes provisions that set forth certain restrictions relating to
2 tests and examinations conducted in medical laboratories. (Chapter 652 of NRS)
3 These restrictions include allowing laboratories to only examine specimens at the
4 request of certain persons, allowing laboratories to report the results of such
5 examinations only to certain persons and allowing only certain persons to
6 manipulate a person for the collection of specimens. (NRS 652.190, 652.210)
7 Existing law also exempts tests and examinations conducted by law enforcement
8 officers and agencies from such provisions. (NRS 652.245) This bill extends the
9 exemption to tests and examinations requested by a court pursuant to a program of
10 treatment and rehabilitation.
