

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 156—ASSEMBLYMAN MABEY

FEBRUARY 22, 2007

Referred to Committee on Ways and Means

SUMMARY—Makes an appropriation to the Blind Center of Nevada for the construction of a facility to provide assistance to persons who are blind or visually impaired. (BDR S-831)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the Blind Center of Nevada for the construction of a facility to provide assistance to persons who are blind or visually impaired; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State
- 2 General Fund to the Blind Center of Nevada the sum of \$7,000,000
- 3 for the construction of a facility to provide assistance to persons of
- 4 all ages who are blind or visually impaired in reaching their highest
- 5 physical, social, intellectual and economic potential.
- 6 2. Upon acceptance of the money appropriated by subsection 1,
- 7 the Blind Center of Nevada shall, upon request of the Legislative
- 8 Commission, make available to the Legislative Auditor any of the
- 9 books, accounts, claims, reports, vouchers or other records of
- 10 information, confidential or otherwise, of the Blind Center of
- 11 Nevada, regardless of their form or location, that the Legislative
- 12 Auditor deems necessary to conduct an audit of the use of the
- 13 money appropriated pursuant to subsection 1.



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- 1 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by
2 subsection 1 of section 1 of this act must not be committed for
3 expenditure after June 30, 2011, by the entity to which the
4 appropriation is made or any entity to which money from the
5 appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and
6 any portion of the appropriated money remaining must not be spent
7 for any purpose after September 16, 2011, by either the entity to
8 which the money was appropriated or the entity to which the money
9 was subsequently granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the
10 State General Fund on or before September 16, 2011.
11 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
