SUMMARY—Revises provisions governing automobile drivers' education. (BDR 34-911)

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EXPLANATION – Matter in ***bolded italics*** is new; matter between brackets [omitted material] is material to be omitted.

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AN ACT relating to education; requiring the boards of trustees of school districts to provide automobile drivers' education, including training both in a classroom and in a motor vehicle; requiring each school district and certain charter schools to prescribe a form that includes the skills a pupil must demonstrate to pass a course in automobile drivers' education; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

- 1       Under existing law, a course in automobile drivers' education must include  
2       training in a classroom and may include training in a motor vehicle. (NRS 389.090)  
3       This bill requires each course to include training both in a classroom and in a motor  
4       vehicle. Under existing law, each school district is authorized to provide  
5       automobile drivers' education for pupils enrolled in high school. (NRS 389.090)  
6       This bill requires each school district to provide automobile drivers' education.  
7       This bill also requires the board of trustees of each school district and each  
8       governing body of a charter school that offers a course in automobile drivers'  
9       education to prescribe a form that includes the skills a pupil must demonstrate to  
10      successfully complete the course.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1      **Section 1.** NRS 389.090 is hereby amended to read as follows:

2      389.090 1. The State Board shall adopt regulations governing  
3      the establishment, conduct and scope of automobile drivers'  
4      education in the public schools of this State. The regulations must  
5      set forth, without limitation:

6            (a) The number of hours of training that must be completed by a  
7      pupil who enrolls in a course in automobile drivers' education;

8            (b) That a course in automobile drivers' education ~~F~~

9            ~~(1) Must~~ **must** include a component of training conducted in  
10     ~~[a]~~:

11            **(1)** ~~A~~ classroom; and

12            ~~(2) [May, in addition to the component of training conducted  
13     in a classroom, include a component of training conducted in a] A~~ **A**  
14     motor vehicle; and

15            (c) That : ~~If a course in automobile drivers' education includes  
16     components of training conducted both in a classroom and in a  
17     motor vehicle:]~~

18            (1) One hour of training in a motor vehicle is equivalent to 3  
19     hours of training in a classroom; and

20            (2) Not more than one-half of the required number of hours  
21     of training described in paragraph (a) may be training in a motor  
22     vehicle.

23            2. The aims and purposes of automobile drivers' education are  
24     to develop the knowledge, attitudes, habits and skills necessary for  
25     the safe operation of motor vehicles.

26            3. The board of trustees of a school district ~~may~~ **shall**  
27     establish and maintain courses in automobile drivers' education  
28     during regular semesters and summer sessions and during the  
29     regular school day and at times other than during the regular school  
30     day for:

31            (a) Pupils enrolled in the regular full-time day high schools in  
32     the school district.

33            (b) Pupils enrolled in summer classes conducted in high schools  
34     in the school district.

35            ➔ A board of trustees ~~maintaining courses in automobile drivers'~~  
36     ~~education]~~ shall insure against any liability arising out of the use of  
37     motor vehicles in connection with those courses. The cost of the  
38     insurance must be paid from available money of the school district.

39            4. ~~A~~ **The** governing body of a charter school may establish  
40     and maintain courses in automobile drivers' education if the  
41     governing body insures against any liability arising out of the use of  
42     motor vehicles in connection with those courses.



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1       5. Automobile drivers' education must be provided by boards  
2 of trustees of school districts and governing bodies of charter  
3 schools in accordance with the regulations of the State Board and  
4 may not be duplicated by any other agency, department, commission  
5 or officer of the State of Nevada.

6       6. Each course in automobile drivers' education provided by  
7 ~~[a]~~ **the** board of trustees of a school district or ~~[a]~~ **the** governing  
8 body of a charter school must include, without limitation ~~[t]~~  
9 **instruction in:**

10     —(a) **Motor:**

11      (a) **A component of training conducted in a classroom and a**  
12 **component of training conducted in a motor vehicle;**

13      (b) **Instruction in motor** vehicle insurance ~~[t]~~

14      —(b) **The**; and

15      (c) **Instruction in the** effect of drugs and alcohol on an operator  
16 of a motor vehicle.

17       7. Each course in automobile drivers' education provided by  
18 ~~[a]~~ **the** board of trustees of a school district or ~~[a]~~ **the** governing  
19 body of a charter school must be restricted to pupils who are at least  
20 15 years of age.

21       8. **The board of trustees of each school district and the**  
22 **governing body of each charter school that provides a course in**  
23 **automobile drivers' education shall prescribe a form that includes**  
24 **each skill a pupil must demonstrate to pass the course. If a pupil**  
25 **passes the course, the teacher of the course, the pupil and his**  
26 **parent or legal guardian shall sign the form indicating that the**  
27 **pupil has successfully demonstrated those skills.**

28      Sec. 2. This act becomes effective on July 1, 2007.



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
