AN ACT relating to the State Environmental Commission; revising
the membership of the Commission; and providing other
matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 Existing law creates the State Environmental Commission within the State
2 Department of Conservation and Natural Resources. The Commission consists of
3 six members designated by statute and five members appointed by the Governor.
4 (NRS 445B.200) This bill provides that, of the five members of the Commission
5 who are appointed by the Governor, one member must have experience and
6 expertise in advocating issues relating to conservation.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 445B.200 is hereby amended to read as
2 follows:
3 445B.200 1. The State Environmental Commission is hereby
4 created within the Department. The Commission consists of:
5 (a) The Director of the Department of Wildlife;
6 (b) The State Forester Firewarden;
7 (c) The State Engineer;
8 (d) The Director of the State Department of Agriculture;
9 (e) The Administrator of the Division of Minerals of the
10 Commission on Mineral Resources;
11 (f) A member of the State Board of Health to be designated by
12 that Board; and
13 (g) Five members appointed by the Governor ~~[one]~~ :
14 (1) *One* of whom is a general engineering contractor or a
15 general building contractor licensed pursuant to chapter 624 of NRS
16 ~~[and one]~~ ;
17 (2) *One* of whom possesses expertise in performing mining
18 reclamation ~~[]~~ ; and
19 (3) *One of whom possesses experience and expertise in*
20 *advocating issues relating to conservation.*
21 2. The Governor shall appoint the Chairman of the
22 Commission from among the members of the Commission.
23 3. A majority of the members constitutes a quorum, and a
24 majority of those present must concur in any decision.
25 4. Each member who is appointed by the Governor is entitled
26 to receive a salary of not more than \$80, as fixed by the
27 Commission, for each day's attendance at a meeting of the
28 Commission.
29 5. While engaged in the business of the Commission, each
30 member and employee of the Commission is entitled to receive the
31 per diem allowance and travel expenses provided for state officers
32 and employees generally.
33 6. Any person who receives or has received during the
34 previous 2 years a significant portion of his income, as defined by
35 any applicable state or federal law, directly or indirectly from one or
36 more holders of or applicants for a permit required by NRS
37 445A.300 to 445A.730, inclusive, is disqualified from serving as a
38 member of the Commission. The provisions of this subsection do
39 not apply to any person who receives, or has received during the
40 previous 2 years, a significant portion of his income from any
41 department or agency of State Government which is a holder of or



1 an applicant for a permit required by NRS 445A.300 to 445A.730,
2 inclusive.

3 7. The Department shall provide technical advice, support and
4 assistance to the Commission. All state officers, departments,
5 commissions and agencies, including the Department of
6 Transportation, the Department of Health and Human Services, the
7 Nevada System of Higher Education, the State Public Works Board,
8 the Department of Motor Vehicles, the Department of Public Safety,
9 the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada, the Transportation
10 Services Authority and the State Department of Agriculture may
11 also provide technical advice, support and assistance to the
12 Commission.

13 **Sec. 2.** As soon as practicable on or after July 1, 2007, the
14 Governor shall appoint to the State Environmental Commission a
15 person who is qualified to serve as a member of the Commission
16 pursuant to subparagraph (3) of paragraph (g) of subsection 1 of
17 NRS 445B.200, as amended by section 1 of this act.

18 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2007.
