

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 246—COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS
(ON BEHALF OF THE NEVADA SUPREME COURT)

SUMMARY—Increases the number of district judges in the Second and Eighth Judicial Districts. (BDR 1-654)

AN ACT relating to courts; increasing the number of district judges in the Second and Eighth Judicial Districts; increasing the number of district judges in the Second and Eighth Judicial Districts who must be judges of the family court; making appropriations; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 **Section 1** of this bill increases the number of district judges in the Second
2 Judicial District, which includes Washoe County, from 12 to 14. (NRS 3.010,
3 3.012) Both of the additional district judges must be judges of the family court,
4 increasing the number of judges of the family court in the Second Judicial District
5 from 4 to 6. (NRS 3.012)

6 **Section 2** of this bill increases the number of district judges in the Eighth
7 Judicial District, which includes Clark County, from 37 to 47. (NRS 3.010, 3.018)
8 Six of the 10 additional district judges must be judges of the family court,
9 increasing the number of judges of the family court in the Eighth Judicial District
10 from 13 to 19. (NRS 3.018)

11 **Section 4** of this bill makes appropriations to pay for the salaries of the
12 additional district judges.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 3.012 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 3.012 For the Second Judicial District there must be **[42] 14**
3 district judges, **[4] 6** of whom must be judges of the family court.

4 **Sec. 2.** NRS 3.018 is hereby amended to read as follows:
5 3.018 For the Eighth Judicial District there must be **[37] 47**
6 district judges, **[3] 19** of whom must be judges of the family court.

7 **Sec. 3.** The additional district judges required for the Second
8 Judicial District pursuant to section 1 of this act and the additional
9 district judges required for the Eighth Judicial District pursuant to
10 section 2 of this act must be selected at the general election held on
11 November 4, 2008, and take office on January 5, 2009. The terms of
12 these judges expire on January 5, 2015.

13 **Sec. 4.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State
14 General Fund to the District Judges' Salary Account the sum of
15 \$130,000 for the salaries of the additional district judges required
16 pursuant to section 1 of this act.

17 2. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to
18 the District Judges' Salary Account the sum of \$650,000 for the
19 salaries of the additional district judges required pursuant to section
20 2 of this act.

21 3. Any remaining balance of the appropriations made by
22 subsections 1 and 2 must not be committed for expenditure after
23 June 30, 2009, and reverts to the State General Fund as soon as all
24 payments of money committed have been made.

25 **Sec. 5.** The provisions of subsection 1 of NRS 354.599 do not
26 apply to any additional expenses of a local government that are
27 related to the provisions of this act.

28 **Sec. 6.** 1. This section and sections 3 and 5 of this act
29 become effective on October 1, 2007.

30 2. Section 4 of this act becomes effective on January 1, 2009.

31 3. Sections 1 and 2 of this act become effective on January 5,
32 2009.
