SUMMARY—Makes an appropriation for the Nevada Senior Olympics. (BDR S-683)

AN ACT making an appropriation for the Nevada Senior Olympics; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State
2 General Fund to Nevada Senior Games, Inc., to fund operational
3 expenses for the Nevada Senior Olympics:

4 For the Fiscal Year 2007-2008..... \$100,000

5 For the Fiscal Year 2008-2009..... \$100,000

6 **Sec. 2.** Upon acceptance of the money appropriated by section
7 1 of this act, Nevada Senior Games, Inc., shall:

8 1. Prepare and transmit a report to the Interim Finance
9 Committee on or before December 15, 2008, that describes each
10 expenditure made from the money appropriated by section 1 of this
11 act from the date on which the money was received by Nevada
12 Senior Games, Inc., through December 1, 2008; and

13 2. Upon request of the Legislative Commission, make available
14 to the Legislative Auditor any of the books, accounts, claims,
15 reports, vouchers or other records of information, confidential or



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1 otherwise, of Nevada Senior Games, Inc., regardless of their form or
2 location, that the Legislative Auditor deems necessary to conduct an
3 audit of the use of the money appropriated pursuant to section 1 of
4 this act.

5 **Sec. 3.** The sums appropriated by section 1 of this act are
6 available for either fiscal year. Any remaining balance of those sums
7 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2009, by the
8 entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity to which
9 money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in
10 any manner, and any portion of the appropriated money remaining
11 must not be spent for any purpose after September 18, 2009, by
12 either the entity to which the money was appropriated or the entity
13 to which the money was subsequently granted or transferred,
14 and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or before
15 September 18, 2009.

16 **Sec. 4.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

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
