SUMMARY—Revises provisions governing the Advisory Council of the Division of Industrial Relations of the Department of Business and Industry. (BDR 18-555)

AN ACT relating to public administration; reducing the number of times the Advisory Council of the Division of Industrial Relations of the Department of Business and Industry is required to meet annually; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

- 1 This bill reduces the number of times that the Advisory Council of the Division
2 of Industrial Relations of the Department of Business and Industry is required to
3 meet annually from two times to one time. (NRS 232.580)
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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** NRS 232.580 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 232.580 1. The Council shall meet at least ~~twice~~ ***once***
3 annually at ~~times and places~~ ***a time and place*** specified by a call of
4 the Chairman, the Administrator or a majority of the Council.
5 Special meetings, not to exceed six per year, may be held at the call
6 of the Chairman, the Administrator or a majority of the Council.



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1 2. The Council shall select from its members a Chairman and *a*
2 Vice Chairman who shall hold office for 1 year. The Administrator
3 shall act as Secretary of the Council.

4 3. The Council may prescribe such bylaws as it deems
5 necessary for its operation.

6 4. Four members of the Council constitute a quorum, and a
7 quorum may exercise all the power and authority conferred on the
8 Council.

9 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on January 1, 2008.
