SUMMARY—Makes an appropriation to the Department of Health and Human Services to extend “Nevada 2-1-1” service to 7 days per week. (BDR S-159)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the Department of Health and Human Services to extend “Nevada 2-1-1” service to 7 days per week; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State
2 General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services to
3 provide funding for the “Nevada 2-1-1” service for 7 days each
4 week, statewide:

5 For the Fiscal Year 2007-2008.....\$1,000,000
6 For the Fiscal Year 2008-2009.....\$1,000,000

7 **Sec. 2.** The sums appropriated by section 1 of this act are
8 available for either year. Any remaining balance of those sums must
9 not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2009, by the entity
10 to which the appropriation is made or any entity to which the money
11 from the appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any
12 manner, and any portion of the appropriated money remaining must



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1 not be spent for any purpose after September 18, 2009, by either the
2 entity to which the money was appropriated or the entity to which
3 the money was subsequently granted or transferred, and must be
4 reverted to the State General Fund on or before September 18, 2009.

5 **Sec. 3.** The appropriation made by the provisions of this act
6 are intended to finance ongoing expenditures of state agencies, and
7 the expenditures financed with those appropriations must be
8 included as base budget expenditures in the proposed budget for the
9 Executive Branch of State Government for the 2009-2011 biennium.

10 **Sec. 4.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

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
