AN ACT relating to wildlife; decreasing the amount of time a person who is 65 years of age or older must reside in this State to qualify for a reduced fee for hunting and fishing licenses; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

- 1 Existing law requires any person 65 years of age or older to have resided in this
2 State continuously for 5 years to qualify for reduced license fees. (NRS 502.245)
3 This bill decreases that period of residency to 6 months.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** NRS 502.245 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 502.245 1. The Department shall issue any hunting or fishing
3 license or combined hunting and fishing license authorized under
4 the provisions of this chapter, upon proof satisfactory of the
