SUMMARY—Requires employment of an administrator to provide services to outreach coordinators who provide information relating to resources available for adults with disabilities. (BDR 38-847)

AN ACT relating to persons with disabilities; requiring the Director of a certain family resource center to employ an administrator to provide certain services to two outreach coordinators who provide information relating to the availability of services, programs, financial assistance and other resources for adults with disabilities; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

- 1 This bill requires the Director of the Ron Wood Family Resource Center to
- 2 employ an administrator to provide education, information and oversight to a
- 3 Northern Nevada Outreach Coordinator and a Southern Nevada Outreach
- 4 Coordinator. The Outreach Coordinators provide information relating to services,
- 5 programs, financial assistance and other resources that are available to adults with
- 6 disabilities and their families from the Department of Health and Human Services,
- 7 the Federal Government, local governments and private organizations. This bill
- 8 requires the Outreach Coordinators to be graduate students at the University of



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9 Nevada, Reno, and the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, who are engaged in a
10 practicum or internship that is a requirement for their degrees.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 430A of NRS is hereby amended by
2 adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

3 ***1. The Director of the Ron Wood Family Resource Center***
4 ***shall employ a part-time administrator, not more than 30 hours***
5 ***per week, to provide education, information and oversight to a***
6 ***Northern Nevada Outreach Coordinator and a Southern Nevada***
7 ***Outreach Coordinator.***

8 ***2. Each Outreach Coordinator shall, under the auspices of***
9 ***the Ron Wood Family Resource Center, provide information***
10 ***relating to the services, programs, financial assistance and other***
11 ***resources that are available to adults with disabilities and their***
12 ***families. The resources for which education and information must***
13 ***be provided include, without limitation, the resources available***
14 ***from the Department of Health and Human Services, the Federal***
15 ***Government, local governments and private organizations.***

16 ***3. An Outreach Coordinator must be:***

17 ***(a) A graduate student in a field of study approved by the***
18 ***Director of the Ron Wood Family Resource Center; and***

19 ***(b) Engaged in a practicum or internship in fulfillment of a***
20 ***requirement for his graduate degree.***

21 ***↪ The Northern Nevada Outreach Coordinator must be enrolled***
22 ***at the University of Nevada, Reno, and the Southern Nevada***
23 ***Outreach Coordinator must be enrolled at the University of***
24 ***Nevada, Las Vegas.***

25 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2007.
