AN ACT relating to higher education; requiring the Legislative Auditor to conduct an audit of the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, with respect to compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

1        This bill requires the Legislative Auditor to conduct an audit of the University  
2        of Nevada, Las Vegas, including the Disability Resource Center, for the purpose of  
3        determining compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, 42  
4        U.S.C. §§ 12101 et seq.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1        **Section 1.** 1. The Legislative Auditor shall conduct an audit  
2        of the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, including the Disability  
3        Resource Center, regarding compliance with the Americans with  
4        Disabilities Act of 1990, 42 U.S.C. §§ 12101 et seq.

5        2. The audit must include an analysis of the offering of suitable  
6        and adequate services to persons with disabilities, including, without  
7        limitation, the provision of:

8              (a) Resources and options for those who need assistance with  
9        walking or movement on campus;

1       (b) Resources and learning tools for the blind, such as CD-ROM  
2 and large-print textbooks;

3       (c) Resources for the hearing impaired, such as hearing devices  
4 and voice-over technology in classrooms and lecture halls;

5       (d) An adequate number of restrooms that are accessible to  
6 persons with disabilities; and

7       (e) Other accommodations required for educational institutions.

8       3. The Legislative Auditor shall present a final written report  
9 of the audit to the Audit Subcommittee of the Legislative  
10 Commission not later than February 2, 2009.

11       4. The provisions of NRS 218.737 to 218.890, inclusive, apply  
12 to the audit conducted pursuant to this section.

13       **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2007.
