AN ACT relating to employment; requiring the Labor Commissioner to include a link on his website to the Social Security Administration for employers to verify employee social security numbers; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 Chapter 607 of NRS sets forth the duties of the Labor Commissioner. This bill
2 expands those duties to require the Labor Commissioner to include on his website a
3 link to the Social Security Administration where an employer may verify the social
4 security numbers of his employees.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 607 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3 *The Labor Commissioner shall include on his Internet website
4 a link which connects to the Social Security Administration where
5 an employer may verify the social security number of an employee.*
