AN ACT relating to employment; requiring the Labor Commissioner to include a link on his website to the Social Security Administration for employers to verify employee social security numbers; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** Chapter 607 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
- 2 thereto a new section to read as follows:
- 3 *The Labor Commissioner shall include on his Internet website*
- 4 *a link which connects to the Social Security Administration where*
- 5 *an employer may verify the social security number of an employee.*
