

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 386—ASSEMBLYMAN MABEY

MARCH 16, 2007

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Referred to Committee on Education

**SUMMARY**—Requires the State Board of Education to adopt regulations governing spirit squads. (BDR 34-1108)

**FISCAL NOTE:** Effect on Local Government: No.

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EXPLANATION – Matter in ***bolded italics*** is new; matter between brackets [omitted material] is material to be omitted.

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AN ACT relating to interscholastic events; requiring the State Board of Education to adopt regulations governing spirit squads; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

1 Existing law requires the State Board of Education to establish policies  
2 governing the supervision, management and control of public schools in Nevada  
3 and authorizes the Board to adopt regulations to carry out the powers and duties  
4 conferred upon the Board by law. (NRS 385.075, 385.080) In addition, existing law  
5 authorizes the Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association to adopt regulations  
6 that are necessary to control, supervise and regulate all interscholastic events at  
7 public schools, charter schools, private schools and parochial schools in Nevada.  
8 (NRS 386.420-386.470) Pursuant to that authority, the Association has adopted  
9 regulations governing the activities of cheerleaders and other members of a spirit  
10 squad at those schools. (NAC 386.754-386.7548)

11 **Section 1** of this bill requires the State Board of Education to adopt regulations  
12 setting forth the standards of safety for each event, competition or other activity  
13 engaged in by a spirit squad and the qualifications required for a person to become  
14 a coach of a spirit squad. **Section 1** further requires the regulations adopted by the  
15 Board to comply substantially with the rules of the Spirit Association of the  
16 National Federation of State High School Associations relating to spirit squad  
17 safety and the qualifications to become a coach of a spirit squad. **Section 2** of this  
18 bill ensures that those regulations apply equally to homeschooled children.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1      **Section 1.** NRS 386.430 is hereby amended to read as follows:  
2      386.430 1. **[The] Except as otherwise provided in subsection**

3 **2, the** Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association shall adopt  
4 rules and regulations in the manner provided for state agencies by  
5 chapter 233B of NRS **H** as may be necessary to carry out the  
6 provisions of NRS 386.420 to 386.470, inclusive. The regulations  
7 must include provisions governing the eligibility and participation  
8 of homeschooled children in interscholastic activities and events.

9      2. **The State Board shall adopt regulations setting forth:**

10     **(a) The standards of safety for each event, competition or  
11 other activity engaged in by a spirit squad of a school that is a  
12 member of the Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association; and**

13     **(b) The qualifications required for a person to become a coach  
14 of a spirit squad.**

15     **3. The regulations adopted pursuant to subsection 2 must, to  
16 the greatest extent practicable, substantially comply with the rules  
17 of the Spirit Association of the National Federation of State High  
18 School Associations or its successor organization relating to the  
19 standards and qualifications specified in subsection 2.**

20     **4. If the Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association intends  
21 to adopt, repeal or amend a policy, rule or regulation concerning or  
22 affecting homeschooled children **H or if, pursuant to this section,  
23 the State Board intends to adopt, repeal or amend a regulation  
24 concerning or affecting those children,** the Association **or the State  
25 Board** shall consult with the Northern Nevada Homeschool  
26 Advisory Council and the Southern Nevada Homeschool Advisory  
27 Council, or their successor organizations, to provide those Councils  
28 with a reasonable opportunity to submit data, opinions or  
29 arguments, orally or in writing, concerning the proposal or change.  
30 The Association **or the State Board** shall consider all written and  
31 oral submissions respecting the proposal or change before taking  
32 final action.**

33     **5. As used in this section, "spirit squad" means any team or  
34 other group of persons that is formed for the purpose of:**

35     **(a) Leading cheers or rallies to encourage support for a team  
36 that participates in a sport that is sanctioned by the Nevada  
37 Interscholastic Activities Association; or**

38     **(b) Participating in a competition against another team or  
39 other group of persons to determine the ability of each team or  
40 group of persons to engage in an activity specified in  
41 paragraph (a).**

1       **Sec. 2.** NRS 386.462 is hereby amended to read as follows:  
2       386.462 1. A homeschooled child must be allowed to  
3       participate in interscholastic activities and events in accordance with  
4       the regulations adopted by the Nevada Interscholastic Activities  
5       Association **and the State Board** pursuant to NRS 386.430.

6       2. The provisions of NRS 386.420 to 386.470, inclusive, and  
7       the regulations adopted pursuant thereto that apply to pupils enrolled  
8       in public schools who participate in interscholastic activities and  
9       events apply in the same manner to homeschooled children who  
10      participate in interscholastic activities and events, including, without  
11      limitation, provisions governing:

- 12           (a) Eligibility and qualifications for participation;
- 13           (b) Fees for participation;
- 14           (c) Insurance;
- 15           (d) Transportation;
- 16           (e) Requirements of physical examination;
- 17           (f) Responsibilities of participants;
- 18           (g) Schedules of events;
- 19           (h) Safety and welfare of participants;
- 20           (i) Eligibility for awards, trophies and medals;
- 21           (j) Conduct of behavior and performance of participants; and
- 22           (k) Disciplinary procedures.

23       **Sec. 3.** NRS 386.464 is hereby amended to read as follows:  
24       386.464 A school district, public school or private school shall  
25      not prescribe any regulations, rules, policies, procedures or  
26      requirements governing the:

27           1. Eligibility of homeschooled children to participate in  
28       interscholastic activities and events pursuant to NRS 386.420 to  
29       386.470, inclusive; or  
30           2. Participation of homeschooled children in interscholastic  
31       activities and events pursuant to NRS 386.420 to 386.470, inclusive,  
32       → that are more restrictive than the provisions governing eligibility  
33       and participation prescribed by the Nevada Interscholastic Activities  
34       Association **or the State Board** pursuant to NRS 386.430.

35       **Sec. 4.** Any regulation adopted by the Nevada Interscholastic  
36       Activities Association which sets forth the standards of safety for  
37       each event, competition or other activity engaged in by a spirit  
38       squad of a school that is a member of the Nevada Interscholastic  
39       Activities Association or the qualifications required for a person to  
40       become a coach of a spirit squad remains in effect until:

41           1. The State Board of Education adopts the regulations  
42       required pursuant to NRS 386.430, as amended by section 1 of this  
43       act; and

44           2. Those regulations become effective.
