

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 388—ASSEMBLYMAN MABEY

MARCH 16, 2007

Referred to Committee on Health and Human Services

SUMMARY—Requires the State Plan for Medicaid to include a provision authorizing pregnant women to obtain certain health care services from any provider of health care of their choice in certain circumstances. (BDR 38-1104)

AN ACT relating to Medicaid; requiring the State Plan for Medicaid to include a provision authorizing pregnant women to obtain certain health care services from any provider of health care of their choice in certain circumstances; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 Existing law provides for health care services for pregnant women who are
2 indigent pursuant to the State Plan for Medicaid. (Chapter 422 of NRS) This bill
3 requires the Director of the Department of Health and Human Services to include in
4 the State Plan for Medicaid a requirement that pregnant women who are eligible for
5 Medicaid may obtain certain health care services from any provider of health care
6 who is qualified and willing to accept the rates, terms and conditions established for
7 other providers of health care.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 422 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:
3 ***The Director shall include in the State Plan for Medicaid a
4 requirement that a pregnant woman who is eligible for Medicaid
5 may receive prenatal and obstetric health care services relating to
6 her pregnancy from any provider of health care, regardless of***



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1 ***whether the provider of health care participates as a provider for***
2 ***the Medicaid managed care program, if:***

3 ***1. The provider of health care is qualified under the laws of***
4 ***this State to provide such care; and***

5 ***2. The provider of health care agrees to accept the rates,***
6 ***terms and conditions established for other providers of health care***
7 ***who participate as providers for the managed care program.***

8 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2007.

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
