SUMMARY—Requires public utilities in larger counties to provide a list of customers for use in the selection of jurors. (BDR 58-651)

AN ACT relating to public utilities; requiring certain public utilities in larger counties to provide a list of customers for use in the selection of jurors; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

- 1 This bill requires a public utility, other than a telephone company, in a county
2 whose population is 400,000 or more (currently Clark County) to provide, upon
3 request, a list of its customers to a district judge or jury commissioner to be used in
4 selecting persons to serve on juries in the same manner as public utilities in the
5 other counties. (NRS 704.206)
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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** NRS 704.206 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 704.206 1. ~~In a county whose population is less than~~
3 ~~400,000, a~~ A public utility, other than a public utility furnishing
4 telephone services, shall provide a list of the names and addresses of
5 the customers of the public utility upon the request of any:
6 (a) District judge; or



1 (b) Jury commissioner,
2 ➔ for use in the selection of jurors.

3 2. The court or jury commissioner who requests the list of
4 customers shall reimburse the public utility for the reasonable cost
5 of compiling the list.

6 3. A disclosure made in good faith pursuant to subsection 1
7 does not give rise to any action for damages for the disclosure of the
8 name and address of a customer by a public utility.

9 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
