SUMMARY—Makes an appropriation to Veterans Guest House, Inc., for operating expenses. (BDR S-1102)

AN ACT making an appropriation to Veterans Guest House, Inc.,
for operating expenses; and providing other matters
properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State
General Fund to Veterans Guest House, Inc., the sum of \$300,000
for operating expenses.

2. The appropriation made by subsection 1 is contingent upon
Veterans Guest House, Inc., obtaining matching money from other
sources. Veterans Guest House, Inc., shall submit proof satisfactory
to the State Controller that the matching money has been committed
before the money appropriated by subsection 1 may be distributed.

3. Upon acceptance of the money appropriated by subsection
1, Veterans Guest House, Inc., shall:

(a) Prepare and transmit a report to the Interim Finance
Committee on or before December 15, 2008, that describes each
expenditure made from the money appropriated by subsection 1
from the date on which the money was received by Veterans Guest
House, Inc., through December 1, 2008;



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(b) Prepare and transmit a final report to the Interim Finance Committee on or before September 18, 2009, that describes each expenditure made from the money appropriated by subsection 1 from the date on which the money was received by the Veterans Guest House, Inc., through June 30, 2009; and

(c) Upon request of the Legislative Commission, make available to the Legislative Auditor any of the books, accounts, claims, reports, vouchers or other records of information, confidential or otherwise, of Veterans Guest House, Inc., regardless of their form or location, that the Legislative Auditor deems necessary to conduct an audit of the use of the money appropriated pursuant to subsection 1.

Sec. 2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2009, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after September 18, 2009, by either the entity to which the money was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or before September 18, 2009.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective on July 1, 2007.
