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AN ACT making an appropriation to Nevada Ballet Theatre, Inc., for expenses relating to a performing tour in northern and central Nevada; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1       **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State  
2 General Fund to Nevada Ballet Theatre, Inc., the sum of \$95,924 for  
3 expenses relating to a performing tour in northern and central  
4 Nevada during November 2007.

5       2. Upon acceptance of the money appropriated by subsection 1,  
6 Nevada Ballet Theatre, Inc., shall:

7           (a) Prepare and transmit a report to the Interim Finance  
8 Committee on or before December 15, 2008, that describes each  
9 expenditure made from the money appropriated by subsection 1  
10 from the date on which the money was received by Nevada Ballet  
11 Theatre, Inc., through December 1, 2008;

12           (b) Prepare and transmit a final report to the Interim Finance  
13 Committee on or before September 18, 2009, that describes each  
14 expenditure made from the money appropriated by subsection 1  
15 from the date on which the money was received by Nevada Ballet  
16 Theatre, Inc., through June 30, 2009; and

1       (c) Upon request of the Legislative Commission, make available  
2 to the Legislative Auditor any books, accounts, claims, reports,  
3 vouchers or other records of information, confidential or otherwise,  
4 regardless of their form or location, which the Legislative Auditor  
5 deems necessary to conduct an audit of the use of the money  
6 appropriated pursuant to subsection 1.

7       **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by  
8 subsection 1 of section 1 of this act must not be committed for  
9 expenditure after June 30, 2008, by the entity to which the  
10 appropriation is made or any entity to which money from the  
11 appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and  
12 any portion of the appropriated money remaining must not be spent  
13 for any purpose after September 19, 2008, by either the entity to  
14 which the money was appropriated or the entity to which the money  
15 was subsequently granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the  
16 State General Fund on or before September 19, 2008.

17       **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
