SUMMARY—Requires providers of health care to provide disclosure of certain financial interests when referring a patient to or recommending physical therapy to a patient. (BDR 54-1300)

AN ACT relating to providers of health care; requiring a provider of health care to provide a written disclosure of certain financial interests that he has when referring a patient to or recommending physical therapy to a patient; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 629 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3 *1. If a provider of health care refers a patient to or
4 recommends that a patient receive physical therapy at a specific
5 facility in which the provider of health care has a financial
6 interest, the provider of health care shall disclose that interest to
7 the patient in writing in a conspicuous manner.*

8 *2. As used in this section:*

9 *(a) "Financial interest" includes, without limitation, any share
10 in the ownership of or profit from a facility at which physical
11 therapy is provided and any form of compensation from a facility
12 at which physical therapy is provided for a prescription for
13 physical therapy.*

14 *(b) "Physical therapy" has the meaning ascribed to it in
15 NRS 640.022.*

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
