SUMMARY—Amends the exceptions authorizing the release of the home address of a peace officer by a law enforcement agency in certain circumstances. (BDR 23-146)

AN ACT relating to peace officers; amending the exceptions that authorize the release of the home address of a peace officer by a law enforcement agency in certain circumstances; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

- 1 This bill authorizes the release of the home address of a peace officer to the
2 public if the officer has been arrested and the home address is included in a report
3 of a 911 telephone call, a police report, a witness statement or certain reports
4 relating to the custody of a child. (NRS 289.025)

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** NRS 289.025 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 289.025 1. Except as otherwise provided in ~~subsection 2,~~
3 **subsections 2 and 3**, the home address and any photograph of a
4 peace officer in the possession of a law enforcement agency are not
5 public information and are confidential.
6 2. The ~~home address and~~ photograph of a peace officer may
7 be released:
8 (a) If the peace officer authorizes the release; or
9 (b) If the peace officer has been arrested.

- 1 3. *The home address of a peace officer may be released if a*
2 *peace officer has been arrested and the home address is included*
3 *in any of the following:*
4 (a) *A report of a 911 telephone call.*
5 (b) *A police report, investigative report or complaint which a*
6 *person filed with a law enforcement agency.*
7 (c) *A statement made by a witness.*
8 (d) *A report prepared pursuant to NRS 432B.540 by an agency*
9 *which provides child welfare services, which report details a plan*
10 *for the placement of a child.*
11 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
