

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 532—COMMITTEE ON COMMERCE AND LABOR

MARCH 26, 2007

SUMMARY—Prohibits certain fees to be charged to certain transactions involving a credit card or debit card. (BDR 52-1397)

AN ACT relating to commercial transactions; prohibiting certain fees to be charged to certain transactions involving a credit card or debit card; providing a civil penalty; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel’s Digest:

1 This bill prohibits certain fees to be charged to certain transactions involving a
2 credit card or debit card. This bill also provides for the imposition of a civil penalty
3 of \$5,000 for each violation, which is recoverable by the Attorney General. Finally,
4 this bill authorizes a merchant who is damaged as a result of a violation to bring a
5 civil action to recover his damages, costs and reasonable attorney’s fees.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** Chapter 597 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
- 2 thereto a new section to read as follows:
- 3 *1. No discount rate, interchange rate, transaction charge or*
- 4 *any other charge or fee charged to a merchant or deducted from*
- 5 *his sales as a charge or fee for processing credit card or debit card*
- 6 *transactions may be applied to any tax portion of the credit card or*
- 7 *debit card sale.*
- 8 *2. Any person who violates subsection 1 is liable for a civil*
- 9 *penalty of \$5,000 for each violation.*
- 10 *3. The Attorney General, in the name of the State of Nevada,*
- 11 *may bring a civil action to recover the civil penalty provided in*

1 *subsection 2. Any money recovered by the Attorney General*  
2 *pursuant to this subsection, after deducting all costs and expenses*  
3 *incurred by the Attorney General to investigate and act upon the*  
4 *violation, must be deposited in the State General Fund.*

5 *4. A merchant who is damaged by a violation of this section*  
6 *may bring a civil action to recover his damages, costs and*  
7 *reasonable attorney's fees.*

8 *5. As used in this section:*

9 *(a) "Credit card" means any instrument or device, whether*  
10 *known as a credit card, credit plate or by any other name, that*  
11 *issued with or without a fee by an issuer for the use of the*  
12 *cardholder in obtaining money, property, goods, services or*  
13 *anything else of value on credit.*

14 *(b) "Debit card" means any instrument or device, whether*  
15 *known as a debit card or by any other name, that is issued with or*  
16 *without a fee by an issuer for the use of the cardholder in*  
17 *obtaining money, property, goods, services or anything else of*  
18 *value, subject to the issuer removing money from the checking*  
19 *account or savings account of the cardholder.*
