

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 539—COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

AN ACT making appropriations to the State Department of Agriculture; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State
2 General Fund to the State Department of Agriculture,
3 Administration, the sum of \$146,660 for the purchase of servers for
4 the Reno and Las Vegas offices and other computer hardware and
5 software, and the replacement of two vehicles.
6 2. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to
7 the State Department of Agriculture for the Plant Industry Program
8 the sum of \$267,045 for the replacement of 14 vehicles.
9 3. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to
10 the State Department of Agriculture, Veterinary Medical Services,
11 the sum of \$60,973 for the purchase of new and replacement
12 laboratory equipment for Reno and Elko and to replace one
13 veterinary vehicle.
14 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriations made by
15 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after
16 June 30, 2009, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or
17 any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or



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1 otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the
2 appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose
3 after September 18, 2009, by either the entity to which the money
4 was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently
5 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General
6 Fund on or before September 18, 2009.

7 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
